It will be taught apart from the Existing hours of teaching / additional hours of teaching (1 hour /day) as a 4 credit paper as an add on course on par with Major Paper and completion of the paper is must to continue his / her studies further. The Extra 6 hrs / cycle will be utilized for the Add on Professional English Course. (As per G.O. No. 76, Higher Education (K2) Department dated: 18.07.2020).
- @ NCC Course is one of the Choices in Non-Major Elective Course. Only the NCC cadets are eligible to choose this course. However, NCC Course is not a Compulsory Course for the NCC Cadets.

### FOR THEORY
