PRESS RELEASE

The letter received from the Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi, (UGC letter D.O.No.F.12-1/2015 (CPP-II) dated 15.10.2015) has informed that the UGC has formulated the Guidelines on Determination of a uniform span period within which a student may be allowed to Qualify for a Degree and informed to implement the same to all affiliated colleges of (Autonomous/Non-Autonomous) this University. In this regard, the syndicate of Bharathidasan University at its meeting held on 06.10.2017 resolved as follows:

- (i) The candidates, admitted on or after 2015-2016 onwards, be allowed to complete the UG/PG Programmes within two years from the completion of programme.
- (ii) Under exceptional circumstances, a further extension of one more year may be granted. The exceptional circumstances be spelt out clearly by the relevant statutory body concerned of the University.
- (iii) During the extended period the student shall be considered as a private candidate and also not be eligible for ranking.
- (iv) Further, the Private candidates who apply for November 2017 and for the subsequent examinations, be informed that they will be permitted to appear only for two chances to complete their respective degree course.
