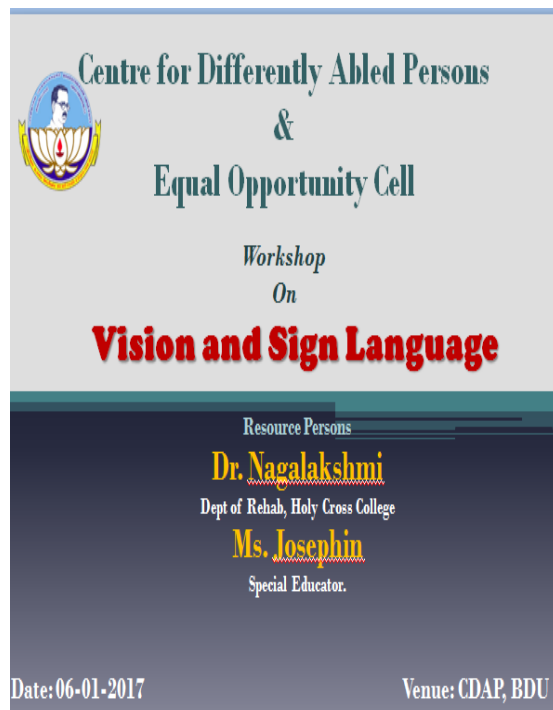

Date: 06-01-2017

A one day workshop on Vision Care and Sign language was organized by the Centre for Differently Abled Persons in Collaboration with Equal Opportunity Cell to create awareness among the students and the public related to Eye Care and Language of the Hearing Impaired.
