Special lecture on Empowering Lives: Advancing Welfare for Differently Abled Individuals and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act

The Equal Opportunity Cell, in conjunction with the Centre Differently Abled Persons Bharathidasan University, conducted a special lecture on assistance systems for individuals with disabilities on September 13, 2022. Dr. M. Ramesh, a physiotherapist at the District Differently Abled Welfare Office in Tiruchirappalli, served as a resource person and disseminated knowledge regarding various welfare schemes and their benefits for those with disabilities. Approximately 55 people engaged in

this event. He provided an in-depth summary of the welfare plan, including scholarships and freeships, and elucidated the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (RPWD Act, 2016) as a crucial legislation in India that guarantees equal rights, protection, and

opportunities for those with disabilities. Dr. Ramesh also emphasized the importance of creating an inclusive society that accommodates individuals with disabilities and promotes their overall well-being. He encouraged the participants to take advantage of the resources available to them and to advocate for their rights within their communities. 
