"Human Rights Day" was observed on 10<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2013. Dr. Abinav Kumar, IPS and Dr. E. Ramganes, Registrar, Bharathidasan University gave their presidential address and flagged off the walkathon. Police officials, students and volunteers joined the walkathon and raised slogans on Equal Human Rights for all without discrimination. The walkathon started from Centre for Differently Abled Persons, Khajamalai campus and ended in TVS tollgate. More than 250 people joined the walkathon.

A special lecture was given by Advocate Vincent. The workshop was held in collaboration with Helping Hearts of Jamal Mohammed College. Advocate Vincent, who is visually



impaired and Dr. Bhuvanewari who is physically impaired advocated for the need for Equal Human rights for persons with or without disabilities. More than 100 persons with or without disabilities interacted with the panel. The workshop gave an insight on the Human Rights issues prevalent among the Persons with Disabilities in education, employment and livelihood. Disability advocacy professionals shared their experiences on Human right issues.
