Applications are invited from **research-focused Faculty Members** from Arts and Science colleges.

- The Capacity Building Programme is designed to strengthen the research competence of the participants, enhance their understanding of the different funding agencies / schemes and build their capacity to prepare winning proposals for research grants.
- The programme would feature sessions by accomplished scientists and academics with proven track record of funded research projects and publications. The sessions will focus on Research Proposal Writing, Funding Agencies / Schemes, Research Ethics, Academic Integrity and Plagiarism, and High-Impact Publications.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

1. Only **Online Applications** will be accepted. Please apply through the Google Form (<https://forms.gle/yh6owwZu3djnpFcn8>). There is **NO REGISTRATION FEE**.
2. **Intake and Selection:** As many as **300** (150 from Humanities & Social Sciences and 150 from Physical and Life Sciences) applicants will be selected on First-cum-First-Served basis for face-to-face participation. Other applicants will be allowed to participate online.
3. The Programme will be in **dual mode** and the offline sessions will be conducted at the **Convocation Hall, Bharathidasan University, Palkalaiperur Campus, Tiruchirappalli**. Online participants will attend the sessions on Google Meet.
4. In case of multiple applications from the same institution, a maximum of two applicants only will be selected, to ensure wider representation.
5. Individual Selection Order will be sent by e-mail to each of the selected applicants along with details of accommodation availability for the needy. Applicants, selected for Online Participation will get the Google Meet Link through e-mail.

About Bharathidasan University

Bharathidasan University, named after the great revolutionary Tamil Poet, Bharathidasan (1891-1968) was established in February 1982. The motto of the University “We will create a brave new world” has been framed from Bharathidasan’s poetic words “புதியதோர் உலகம் செய்வோம்”. The University endeavours to be true to such a vision by creating in the region a brave new world of academic innovation for social change”. The University’s main campus in a sprawling area of over 500 acres is located at Palkalaiperur. In addition to the administrative complex, which includes the Vice-Chancellor’s Secretariat, Registrar’s Office, Finance and Examination offices, most of the academic departments and research laboratories are located in this campus. The downtown campus (Khajamalai Campus) has the Departments of Economics, Social Work, Computer Science, the Centre for Remote Sensing, the UGC-MMTTC and others.
