### **Name of the Programme:**

**Intellectual Property Rights**

**(Value Added Course)**

### **Eligibility for admission:**

A candidate seeking admission shall not be more than 25 years of age currently enrolled in UG/PG/Integrated Programme of Bharathidasan University or any other recognised academic institution.

### **Duration of the Programme:**

Academic year 30 hours in week ends or after working hours of the institution.

### **Programme Fees :**

Each student admitted to the Value Added Course will pay: Tuition Fees Rs. 1000/- \* and discounts permissible as per the Bharathidasan University rules and regulations.

- **\*These fees are subject to change as per University norms.**

### **Board of Studies:**

The Board of Studies for academic programme, Syllabus etc., will consist of three members of the Intellectual Property Rights cell, two external subject experts from other Universities or institution and

Industrial expert if required. The Coordinator of Intellectual Property Rights Cell shall be the Chairman.

### **Code and Credits:**

The code name is given as IPRVAC01 and the course credit shall be two (2).

### **Syllabus:**

The Syllabus for the value added Course is designed keeping in view the usefulness of the Course to the students for (1) continuation of academic activity leading to research with IPR Protection, (2) employability in Intellectual Property Rights related vocations and (3) Self-employment skill development.

The course has contain 6 units among that the first 5 units are taught in view of examination purpose and the 6<sup>th</sup> unit is to inculcate recent developments in the field and not for examination.

### **Continuous Internal Assessment (IA):**

The Internal assessment component for each student will include regularity in attending classes, flash/quick tests, model exams, assignments and/or seminars.

The Internal assessment component will be 25% of the marks allotted to the Course and evaluated by class teacher.

The passing minimum marks for internal assessment is 10 (i.e. 40% of the IA).

### **University Examination (UE):**

The question paper setters for the University examinations in theory will be selected from a panel of examiners suggested by the course teachers. There will be a single valuation of the theory papers by internal examiners.

The University exam will be conducted for a total of 75 marks.

The candidate should have scored at least 30 marks (i.e. 40% of the EA). To pass each course the candidate should get in Grand Total  $\geq 50$  marks (the internal marks for (IA=25) + (EA=75) = must be  $\geq 50$  (i.e 50% of the total)) out of 100.

- Instant examination shall be possible only for absentees or failed candidates in the current University examination (UE) subject to intimation to IPR cell within a week of publish of result from their respective departments. Examination fee and other fees are based on University norms.

### **Examination Fees:**

Following the University rules and regulations it is subject to change

### **Attendance:**

Students must have earned 75% of attendance in each course for appearing for the examination. Students who have earned 70% to 74% of attendance to be applied for condonation in the prescribed form with the prescribed fee of Rs.400/- (Rupees four hundred). Students who have earned 60% to 69% of attendance to be applied for condonation in the prescribed form with the prescribed fee of Rs.400/- (Rupees four hundred) along with the medical certificate.

Students who have earned below 60% of attendance are not eligible to appear for the examination.
