Dr. G. Mathan, Professor and Head of the Department, delivered the welcome address, highlighting the importance of parental involvement in the educational process.

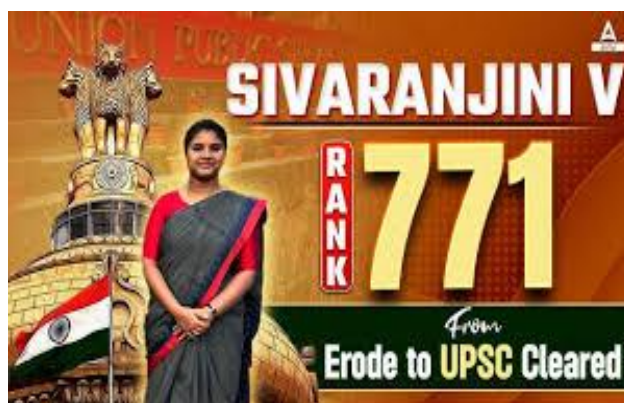


2. Academic Performance Review
