One day Seminar on "Gender Perspective of Child Rights in Sweden and India" on 18.02.2013



Department of Women's Studies, Bharathidasan University organized a one day seminar on Gender Perspective on Child Rights in Sweden and India" on 18th February 2013. A team from Save the Children, Sweden, Ms Ms Rebecca Padar, Ms Sandra Ammitzboll, Ms. Anna Sandkall and others were invited as resource persons to share their experience on Child Rights in Sweden and India. They explained that the Save the Children Movement was started at New Delhi. Before independence it was like a voluntary organization and after the independence, the movement started working for rights of the children. Ms. Anna Sandkall talked about the need for training on child rights to generate awareness. She discussed about training manual prepared and sought for the inputs from the participants. The manual will be used for creating awareness among the children whose rights are denied. The manual consists of eight components which include gender as one component. After discussing with the participants, Ms.Rebecca Padar expressed that they realized, every components in the manual should be sought in a gender perspective.
